ESSENTIAL GATHERINGS

The Australian Health Protection Principal Committee (AHPPC) has established a list for what constitutes essential gatherings. The AHPPC has banned non-essential gatherings of 100 people or more indoors, and 500 people or more outdoors.

- Airports
- Public transport (buses, trains, ferries, platforms, stations)
- Shopping centres, food markets, supermarkets
- Factories
- Medical and health services
- Emergency health services
- Disability or aged care facilities
- Correctional facilities
- Youth justice facilities
- Courts or tribunals
- Parliaments
- Office buildings

- Construction sites
- Mining sites
- Schools and universities
- Childcare centres
- Hotels, motels and other accommodation
- Places where people are transiting necessary for normal operation (ie open air malls)

Social distancing and good hygiene should be practiced where possible in these areas.
